For fretted dulcimer, some notes tied with with a slur are played with a slide (S), a hammer-on (H), or a pull-off (P) as indicated. Guitar chords pause after the downbeat A chord at measure 23 and come back in on the G chord in measure 25, see page 2.

I recorded this in the key of F, but today my friends and I play it in D as shown here. I also like to play it in A on a baritone mountain dulcimer. This is the title tune on the CD *Moonlight On The River*. Sheet music for both the key of D and F are in the book *Moonlight On The River Tune Book IV*.
